Our new Block of the Month, Patriots in Petticoats, will start in January. This quilt features reproduction fabrics from the Revolutionary War era and focuses on a different woman who was important to the cause every month. Gail has finished several blocks and they are in the shop. The price will be \$25/month for 12 months.



Quilt Market in Houston was overwhelming as usual. I wanted to get it all for you but had to control myself. There were things, of course, that I couldn't resist.

We now have the X-Block book and rulers in 2 sizes. Another interesting new ruler is the Creative Grids Quick Trim Ruler. Not only does this have lines to make half-square triangles and flying geese easier; it also has holes to draw circles up to 22". We'll be using it to demonstrate folded napkins during our Birthday celebration.

Amy Bradley has two new patterns out. They are Traveling Turtles and My Alphabet Quilt. There are also two new Garden Patch Cats, Pickle Puss and Pepper Puss.

For all of you embellishment fans, we now have a selection of silk ribbon and some new buttons. There is also a basket of fabric pins that are gorgeous.

Since we are going to be having a new sit-n-sew that uses strips and scraps, we'll have a Sizzix to speed up the cutting. Of course that means we will be able to make our own jelly rolls and charm packs rather than being limited to what is available from the manufacturers.


