#### Machine Quilting ... Joyce

Here are the basics of machine quilting. You will learn how to set up your machine, the needles, threads and notions to use and free motion stitching. There is ample time for hands on practice.

## Yellow Brick Road...Pat Abersold

Here is a new twist on a basic circle pattern quilt. This quilt as you go method is easy to make into any size and is reversible.

#### Civil War Stitch Along...Gail
