The Stitching Society that meets on the third Sunday of the month has been so popular that we are adding a session on the third Monday of each month from 10-12 starting in February. You are welcome to stay longer if you would like. Let me know soon if you are interested because it takes a while for the materials to arrive.

This program, designed to work with wool, has a monthly packet of applique motifs, a small project pattern every month and a sizeable collection of embroidery stitches. It is designed to be a year long program. The cost is \$60 to enroll, and \$10/month for the first 6 months.

We have been concentrating on embroidery during the class time after a brief discussion of wool applique techniques the first session.

For those of you who just want to have a wool sit and stitch, Karen Penrod is starting a group on the first Monday of every month meeting from 12-4...any pattern or technique...it just needs to be wool.
