NEW TWO DAY CLASS

Beginning Quilting...Nancy



Do you know someone who wants to learn to quilt or do you need to brush up on your basics?

Our beginning quilting class is a 25"x25" wall hanging or table topper that includes four patches and half square triangles. You will learn fabric selection, accurate cutting and piecing

a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam. The number of blocks can be increased if you prefer a larger quilt.
